Raises qualification by developing supervisor's competencies in accordance with the "ECVision. A European Competence Framework of Supervision and Coaching <sup>2</sup> ".	At least 6 hours per year.	The supervisor provides information on his / her participation in the training in the annual activity report and identifies the competencies he/ she has developed.
Provides supervision services.	Has at least one supervision process per year	
Actively contributes to LPSKA activities.	Participates in LPSKA activities and events, helps to organize and to implement them.	The list of activities listed below is not complete but merely example. Possible activities are: a member of LPSKA could work in the LPSKA board, organize supervision of supervision, meetings, professional development and other events, submits annual reports, writes and submits the articles on the topic of supervision, etc.
