Fundamental projects :

- **Redesign** of the PSF's accreditation process for an effective start in 2021.
- **With the SIMACS,**
 - writing of coaches and supervisor's job descriptions,
 - recognition of private schools by French State, according to a standardized reference system
 - Have NAF (APE) codes created for coaches and supervisors
(Industry & Business classification under activity codes in France).
- **Membership:** increased by 20% in 2020 (2018 38, 2020: 58)

I- Main highlights within PSF 2018/2020 - continued

- **Creation of Simacs** (Interprofessional Union of Helping professions, Coaching and Supervision Trades) - mid 2019
- **Brings together:** Main national associations : EMCC France, ICF France, SF Coach, PSF and Synpaac (and growing: one additional end of 2020 : Cecorp, 2 more in the radar)
- **Goals :**
 - represent and defend the help professions alongside the French government and regulatory bodies
 - Recognize the roles of coaches first, and then the role of supervisors, as full-fledged jobs referenced by the State
 - Speak with a united voice on behalf of these professions
- PSF is represented on the Board by:
 - Martine Volle – PSF’s President
 - Emmanuel Muh - PSF’s Vice president in charge of Partnerships and also the treasurer of Simacs
- PSF will assume the vice-presidency in 2021, then the presidency in 2022.

II. Present or foreseeable Challenges in the immediate future

- After having structured the federation, organized 3 conferences on supervision, created connections in Europe with ANSE and in France within SIMACS, new challenges await PSF:
 - PSF being ANSE representative in France and radiate at French-speaking audiences as well as at European levels (example: encourage and raise awareness of IIG (International Intervention Groups : currently 1 participant) and DIG (Digital interplay Groups : currently 3 participants) in France.
 - Continue to work to the knowledge of supervision and its specific role,
 - Finalize the redesign of PSF accreditation process,
 - Increase relationships with different audiences (SIMACS vice Presidency in 2021, development of relationships with Companies, welcoming supervisors from different audiences),
 - Amplify the role of PSF as a relay of information and reflection in the field of supervision for all those involved in support and helping professions.
 - Increase the membership number with the objective of more than 100 members by the end of 2021

III. Meaning of our contribution - The canopy of supervision

- Contribute to the recognition of ANSE/PSF supervisor's skills at the European level.
- Willing to organize next ANSE Summer University or next ANSE GA in France.
- Fostering interactions between ANSE and PSF supervisors in order to share and promote reciprocal inspirations.
- Share our research and developments both in supervision practices and supervision trends in France. Compare views between countries.
- Work about requirements/criterias for becoming an ANSE full member.
