We refreshed good cooperation with EASC; we act as a „critical friend“ in their application for a new EU-project



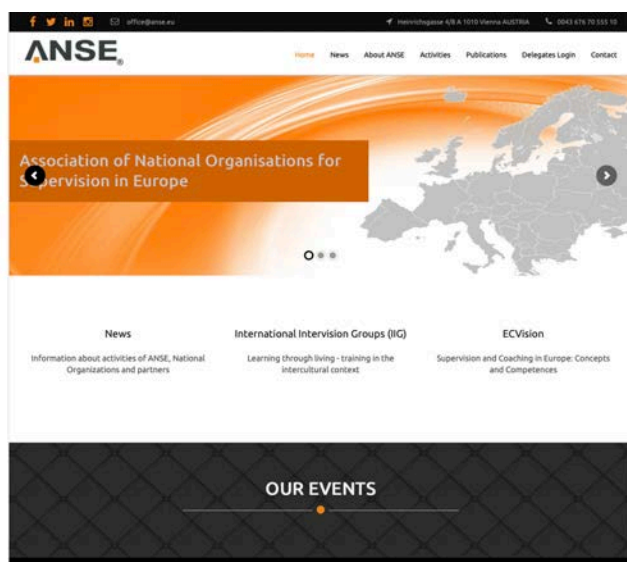
