- **ÖVS Supervision successfully assigned to NQF level VI**

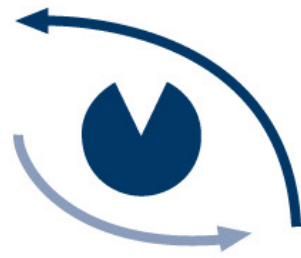
The National Qualification Framework assigned ÖVS certified Supervision to its qualification level VI.

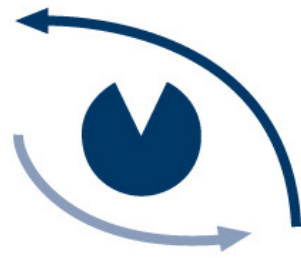

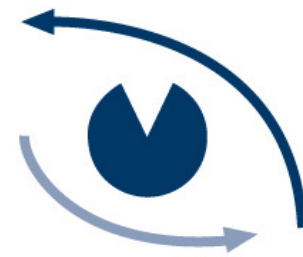


Solidarity of the supervisors with Ukraine

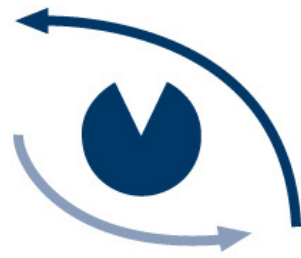
1st European Day of Supervision & Coaching

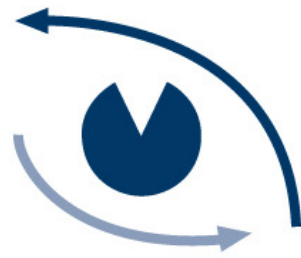


Join us in the European Supervision Song Contest
