The wide range of perspectives in the external world is reflected in the internal world, in which the individual unites many, sometimes even conflicting, roles.

Our society is also described as a VUCA world: Volatile, Uncertain, Complex and Ambiguous. In this moving world, individuals, organisations and societies feel the need for security. For example: the trend to standardise in organisations, the consolidation of the current dominant neoliberal culture, the strengthening of external borders, the call for preservation of identity at different levels and the expression or suppression of strong emotions.
